There will be no dressing up this year, but we have lots of exciting activities planned in school, all celebrating the wonderful world of books!

### Book Swap

On <u>Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> March</u> all children are invited to bring a maximum of three books into school to swap. Please make sure books brought into school for the book swap are appropriate for primary school aged children. We would like to encourage you to bring fiction and non-fiction books to swap (no quiz books, sticker/activity books or annuals please).

### **Book Breakfast**

Children and a parent or carer are invited to attend a book breakfast from 8.30am - 8.50am, where they can share a book and have breakfast before the school day starts. This will be:

- Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> March Key Stage 2 (Y3-6) in the hall
- Thursday 7th March Foundation Stage (Rec & Nursery) in the Foundation Unit
- Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March for Key Stage I (YI-2) in the hall

Please note that if an adult is unable to come into school, children will go to their classrooms as usual, so please do not send them into school early if they have no adult.

### **Book Vouchers**

Before half term, your child will be bringing home their £1 World Book Day voucher, which is valid from Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> February until Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> March.
