Dear Year I and Year 2 Parents and Carers,

We will be travelling there by coach using our Sports Funding to cover the cost of this and the cost of the entry into the event.

We need to arrive at the venue for a prompt 9.15am opening ceremony. A coach will pick us up from school at 8.30am so that we can get to the EIS in plenty of time. Please can the children arrive at school no later than 8.20am. They will need to enter school via the Derbyshire Lane entrance so that we can register them in time to get on the coach. Unfortunately, we do need to leave at 8.30am promptly so will be unable to wait for latecomers.

We will be back in school at the end of lunchtime. The children will eat their packed lunches in class and lessons will be as normal in the afternoon.

Parents are welcome to come as spectators to the event but will need to make their own way to and from the venue. The organisers have advised us that parents may watch but they must do so from the balcony.
