Dear Parents and Carers,

Y3 have been invited to attend the Sheffield Children's Book Award ceremony on **Friday 4th November** at the Crucible Theatre in Sheffield.

Last year our school took part in the Sheffield Children's Book Award. This involved children reading a selection of recommended books and voting for their favourite. Children in lots of different schools across Sheffield voted for their favourite books and the results of the vote have now been collated. Results are being kept a closely guarded secret, but will finally be revealed at the award ceremony which promises to be really exciting for the children.

We will take children from school at 9.15am and catch the bus (from Chesterfield Rd) into the city centre. We will be leaving school straight after registration so please ensure your child is on time as we are unable to wait for any late pupils. Following the ceremony we will eat our packed lunches in the Winter Gardens before returning to school.

The cost of this trip is £1.60 which covers the travel to and from town. (This is a voluntary contribution, but without sufficient funds, we will be unable to fund this through the school budget.) This contribution should be paid via ParentPay by half term please. Additionally, we need some Parent volunteers. If you would be available to support then please contact me via class dojo.

Your child will need a waterproof coat and a packed lunch. If your child is entitled to free school meals a packed lunch and a bottle of water will be provided for them.

The children will also have the opportunity to buy a book and get it signed by one of the authors. This is optional, so if you would like to do this, please can you send your child with some money in a named envelope/purse (we normally find around £10 is enough).
