Dear Parents and Carers,

Last term your child started attending our choir rehearsals which have been going wonderfully. We have been working towards the Young Voices event which will be at 7pm on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> February at the Arena.



Tickets and T-shirts are now on sale to schools (tickets will be opened up to the general public later this month, although they may cost more than face value and will be subject to a booking fee). Tickets are priced at £23 each (unfortunately there are no concessions) for spectators. (Obviously all of the children performing are admitted free of charge!)

T shirts in all sizes are £15 plus £1 P&P and include a torch. **You do not need to purchase an official T shirt in order to perform** – in this instance children are asked to wear a plain white T shirt instead. Young Voices have asked us to remind you that children with non-official copies of T shirts or any other reflective or light up devices will not be admitted into the venue. T shirts will not be available to purchase after the deadline.

If you would like to purchase tickets please do so via ParentPay. If you would like to purchase more than one ticket please change the quantity to the required amount.

If you would like to purchase a T-shirt you can pay for this on Parent Pay but you will also need to complete the paper form to indicate the required size and return to school so that we can order them for you.

In order for us to be able to collate and confirm all orders before the deadline please make sure all monies and forms are returned no later than **Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> November**. Money and forms received after this date may not be processed.

We will be making a decision regarding travel to the venue shortly. We have 2 options available to us:

1. Travel to the venue on public transport and meet parents at a designated spot after the performance. This will be a much cheaper option, however it can often be busy and we can't guarantee that other schools don't choose the same spot to use as a rendezvous.
2. Travel to and from the venue via coach. This would be a more expensive option and in our past experience delays for the coaches or parents leaving the venue can mean either party are waiting for a long time back at school.

We will go with the majority opinion so I would be grateful if you could communicate your preference here:

If the majority choose to opt for a coach, this can be paid closer to the time via Parent Pay.

We will also require a parent volunteer. You will be required at school at 12.30 and will need to stay with us until all the children are reunited with their parents at the end of the evening. Chaperones are admitted into the arena for the performance free of charge. If you would like to volunteer please let me know by the end of this week. (Please do not purchase tickets for yourself before this date as it will be tricky to issue refunds.) If there is a lot of interest, in the interest of fairness, I will put names in a hat and inform all interested parties so you still have time to order a ticket.
